From time to time, the Forum receives requests for financial support from local residents. This policy clarifies when we may be able to help.

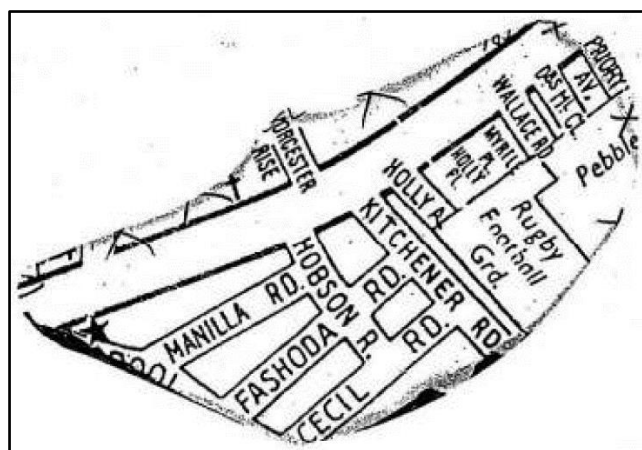
## Policy

The Forum may be able to provide limited funding to support specific community needs, subject to available resources. Priority will be given to the purchase of items or services which benefit the safety and well-being of Selly Park South neighbourhood residents and improve the appearance of the local area – for example, helping to reduce rubbish, fly-tipping and graffiti. Please see below for a map of the area covered by our funding.

We have a small annual budget, so it is unlikely we would be able to contribute more than £150 to any single request. Forum funds must benefit a majority or number of residents, not sole individuals or households. We also require that, wherever possible, residents provide a cash or in-kind contribution themselves, to enable Forum funds to go further. Before releasing any funds, we would require receipts as evidence of purchase.

Decisions will be made by the Committee, based on evidence of need and with the aim of making best use of Forum resources. While we are unable to fund every request, we will endeavour to help where we can.
